Your donations go a long way in transforming our beneficiaries' lives. When you give, you are extending a helping hand to our beneficiaries in our social centres:

Gracehaven provides a full continuum of care for children and youth who require out-of-home care and protection or rehabilitation due to family breakdowns, risk behaviours and a lack of parental supervision. Our services range from residential care, interim placement and assessment, fostering and home-based intervention to reunify residents with their natural families in a safe and timely manner.

The Haven provides a stable and loving home environment for children and youth who are unable to be cared for by their own families and face low probability of family reintegration. Individual care plans, together with academic and enrichment programmes and independent living skills training, help them build positive self-esteem and achieve their full potential.

Prison Support Services - Kids In Play provides professional support to families of incarcerated persons such as casework management, counselling and practical help or referrals for assistance. We address the impact of incarceration on the children of incarcerated parents and their caregivers, and help facilitate the reintegration of former inmates with their families and the community upon release.

Youth Development Centre embraces a vision of empowering at-risk low income youth and unleashing their full potential by providing opportunities for them to pursue their interests, learn life skills and socialize in a healthy environment. Aftercare services are also offered to those who are either discharged from our residential homes or who are in non-residential care but require further mentoring.

Family Support Services help struggling families cope in the community. We provide casework management, counselling, food ration, financial assistance, health check services and support groups for the elderly and youth.

Peacehaven Nursing Home provides a comprehensive gamut of quality services to care for the frail and elderly requiring nursing care. In addition, we have a transitional convalescent facility, Grace Corner which provides lower-intensity rehabilitation.

Peacehaven Day Centres at Bedok and Changi offer the Integrated Home and Day Care Programme. This day programme provides a combination of centre-based and home care for elderly living in the community.

Sojourn engages the male migrant worker community to enhance their quality of life and improve the social integration between the local and migrant communities. We offer basic English language classes, counselling services, skills development classes and recreational activities.

Carehaven conducts meaningful programmes for domestic employees in collaboration with the Centre for Domestic Employees. Our programmes aim to engage and equip the foreign domestic workers, to allay their fears and help walk alongside them to overcome any challenges that they may encounter.
