Life was not always this good for Bob. As a child he was not treated well by his father who went in and out of prison. Eventually his parents divorced and his mum struggled to find employment to be able to cope financially. All this resulted in Bob lacking good nutrition, proper supervision and losing focus in his studies. During the same period, he was influenced by classmates who were leading him towards criminal activity.

Through help from the pre-teen student care service, Bob received from The Salvation Army what his family could not provide. He found support to focus on his studies and everyone celebrated when he passed his Primary School Leaving Examination. With the loving care of dedicated staff, Bob began to discover his potential and many talents. He also learned good moral values.

William Booth Corps Youth Ministry mentors welcomed Bob and provided him a place of love and attention. He now has a large and diverse church family of uncles, aunties and peers who encourage him to stay focus on reaching his full potential.

A place for children, young people and families, William Booth Corps@Bukit Panjang provides a holistic, nurturing and loving environment where understanding and help are shared with families in community.

Pre-teen Student Care

We provide holistic academic and moral education support for students from primary three to six. Our focus is on meeting the pre-teens physical, mental, spiritual and emotional developmental needs. Academic studies include supervision in school work and help in reading for English, Chinese and Tamil languages.

Secondary Student Care and 'Street Level' Youth Hub

Our pilot programme in Secondary Student Care for lower secondary students seeks to assist young people with the transition from primary to secondary school in a safe and caring environment.

'Street Level' Youth Hub engages youth-at-risk from the community by providing care and counselling, inculcating good study habits and developing wholesome hobbies. Our diverse workshops comprise leadership development, life skills, art, music and photography to help young people discover their strengths and talents.

Special Needs Family Focus

A number of families struggle with their children's special education needs and we are reaching out to them by providing assistance from our in-house teaching specialist. Our in-house library provides a conducive environment for young people to develop good reading habits and also serves as a useful teaching resource.

WBC Community Services

Our community services provide practical help to families in need who live in the northern and western parts of Singapore.

Home League for Women

William Booth Corps Home League runs regular programmes for women so that they can enjoy the friendship of other women, learn new skills and visit local places of interest.
