### Touching Lives

Mdm Tan aged 96 is wheelchair bound and diagnosed with severe dementia. Mdm Tan's elder daughter, Alice, took on three jobs a day to support the family financially; while her younger daughter, Jane, cared for Mdm Tan even though she was suffering from psychiatric issues. Sadly, Jane's condition deteriorated and required regular treatments at the Institute of Mental Health. This left Alice struggling as her younger sister could no longer care for their mother. Mdm Tan was then referred to The Salvation Army Peacehaven Bedok Day Centre and Jane joined her a year later to receive better care. Alice is relieved knowing that both her mother and sister are well taken care of and can continue living in the community for as long as possible.



## Caring for the Elderly in the Community

Peacehaven Day Centres provide holistic care to frail elderly with a comprehensive suite of care services tailored to each individual. We offer the Integrated Home and Day Centre Programme which provides medical, nursing, rehabilitation, psychosocial support, home assessment and personal care at the centre and at the client's home.

Reaching out to clients with multiple-care needs, including dementia, the programme aims to deliver seamless care even as their needs change with time. A multidisciplinary approach is adopted in developing the client's individualised care plan, taking into consideration the client's needs and goals. Supported by a case manager, occupational therapist, physiotherapist and medical social worker, there will also be a care review to assess the client's outcomes and care plan or when there are significant changes in a client's status.

Our one-stop centres, serving mostly clients on government subsidy, aim to improve the quality of life of our senior citizens and also provide early intervention so that they can continue living in the community for as long as possible. Peacehaven is a member of Eastern Heath Alliance and collaborates with other healthcare providers in the region to form a seamless model of care.
