AIDING NEEDY FAMILIES



Mdm Ng* is a single mother and has two daughters, who were diagnosed with bipolar disorder and obsessive compulsive disorder when they were younger. Mdm Ng's younger daughter, Mei*, suffers from a psychiatric disorder and depends on others for her daily activities. Mdm Ng's older daughter, Ling*, has better cognitive abilities, and worked as a retail assistant after she completed her secondary school education. However, her condition worsened and she was certified to be unfit for work.

Mdm Ng, who is now 80, first approached The Salvation Army for help a decade ago. Over the years, Family Support Services provided Mdm Ng with food rations, counselling and emotional support. In 2020, Mdm Ng fell and was hospitalised. As a result of the fall, Mdm Ng started to display early symptoms of dementia. As a bipolar patient, Ling came under tremendous stress, having to keep track of her mother's treatments while caring for her younger

sister. On the verge of despair, she turned to us for support again.

Sensing that Ling was emotionally overwhelmed, we sat down with her and assured her that we will resolve their issues together. We helped her to prioritise their needs and provided escort services for Ling and Mei to visit their mother. Our social worker also took the time to explain to them the doctor's updates on their mother's condition. In addition, we assisted Ling to apply for financial assistance from the government and worked with the medical social worker to find support for Mdm Ng, after she was discharged. The family situation has since stabilised, and Mdm Ng is now back home and receiving home nursing care.

With your kind contribution, we can help many more underprivileged families who have often gone unnoticed. Thank you for giving generously.

黄女士*是一位单亲妈妈，她独自将两个女儿抚养长大。不幸的是，她的两个女儿在小的时候一个患有躁郁症，另一个则患有强迫症。其中，黄女士的小女儿阿美*还患有精神病，日常起居都需要依靠其他人的帮助。黄女士的大女儿阿玲*智力发育比较健全，她中学毕业后就出来工作，是一名售货员。可惜，后来她的病情恶化，也无法工作了。

黄女士今年已经80岁了，她在10年前向救世军求助。这些年来，救世军家庭支援服务 (Family Support Services) 一直为黄女士一家派送食品，提供辅导并给予情感与精神上的支持。2020年，黄女士不幸跌倒并住院。自此以后，黄女士便出现了初期失智症的症状。由于阿玲是一名躁郁症患者，她承受了极大的压力，既要确保母亲得到适当的治疗，又得照顾妹妹。由于感到彷徨无助，阿玲再次向救世军求助。

由于本军的职员感觉到阿玲精神和情绪都几近崩溃，我们不停地安慰她，并保证会跟她一起解决困难。我们先帮她厘清哪些问题急需处理，并为阿玲和阿美提供载送服务，好让她们到医院去探望妈妈。本军的一名社工还花时间跟她们姐妹俩解释医生所提到的有关母亲的病况。另一方面，我们还协助阿玲向政府申请财务援助，并跟医疗社工合作，设法在黄女士出院后寻求适当的协助。经过这些努力，黄女士一家的情况总算稳定下来了，如今黄女士已经出院回家了，并在家接受居家护理。

The theme for each session is shared with the children through songs, storytelling and art and crafts.

Through these sessions, we hope that the children will become resilient individuals by acquiring prosocial values to cope with their losses arising from the incarceration of their parents. We also provide a supportive community for the children to have positive interactions with one another and with our volunteers in a safe social space.

During the March school holidays, Youth Development Centre organised a variety of activities to engage youth from less privileged backgrounds. The activities spanned across different interests that included an art competition and a games day.

The theme for the art competition was to draw what they enjoyed most at the centre, and contestants were required to work with volunteers to brainstorm ideas and present their finished artwork to their peers. On games day, we held an array of competitions such as cup stacking, mini basketball, and maze running. Our youth and volunteers built stronger bonds with one another and spent an exhilarating day together.
